Many food aid organizations ask for government-issued ID, income documents, or even proof of immigration status to access their services, which many non-status residents do not have. However, this varies from organization to organization. There are a number of food aid services – food banks, community cafeterias, collective kitchens and low-cost food stores – that are open to anyone, regardless of immigration status. Some of these places ask for no documents, and others will accept referral letters from organizations like Solidarity Across Borders. Below is a list of some of these food aid services in Montréal, along with their requirements for access, operational hours, and costs.

The Food for All committee of Solidarity Across Borders works with a variety of food aid organizations to fight for accessibility to food services for all – especially for those with precarious immigration status.
