No One Is Illegal-Montreal supports Ivonne Hernandez, a survivor of conjugal violence and a single mother of a one-year old, in her struggle to remain in Canada. We believe Ivonne has faced an uphill battle against the justice and immigration systems in her attempts to remain close to her son. We believe it is deplorable that the Canadian Immigration system seeks to deport a survivor and separate her from her one-year old child. We stand in solidarity with Ivonne's demands:

- WE demand that Minister Alexander immediately regularize Ivonne Hernandez's status in Canada, which he has the power to do.
- WE demand that Minister Blaney cancel the removal order against Ivonne Hernandez, which he has the power to do.
- WE demand that Minister De Courcy directly intervene in this case to demand that Minister Alexander regularize Ivonne Hernandez's status.

The Canadian Immigration system is standing with an abuser against a loving and caring single mother. This is not a surprising move by Immigration Canada as they separate thousands of families each year; protect abusers; and, force non-status women into vulnerable situations. The whole immigration system is corrupt and inhumane; predicated on power, violence, and control. Most migrants are displaced and migrate because of corporate greed and the policies of imperialist powers. Although they are told they are undesirable, capitalist industries and settler colonial states require migrant and non-status people in order to reap high profits. This dehumanization of migrants is reinforced by racism. Ivonne is another example of a migrant deemed unworthy and being forced back to a country where rates of domestic violence and homicide are extremely high.

We stand in solidarity with Ivonne and urge others to do the same!
